SPECIAL PROVISION

REGARDING

PROJECT COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

This project shall be completed in its entirety on or before June 30, 2017.

All work on the ITS portion of the project through Conditional System Acceptance (as defined in Special Provision 725) shall be completed on or before June 30, 2017.

All lane closures must be approved in advance by the Engineer. A minimum of seven days notice must be provided in advance of any closure. Temporary lane closures shall only be allowed from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. For each hour, or portion thereof, in which traffic is impeded outside these limits, the amount of \$1,000 per hour per lane shall be deducted from the contractor, not as penalty but as liquidated damages.

Rolling roadblocks may be utilized for blasting, for hanging structures, or at the discretion of the Engineer. Rolling roadblocks shall not exceed twenty minutes in duration. For each 20 minute period, or portion thereof, in which traffic is impeded outside these limits, the amount of \$500 per 20 minute period per lane shall be deducted from the contractor, not as penalty but as liquidated damages. Traffic shall be allowed to return to normal flow before beginning the next rolling road block.

No lane closures will be allowed during Special Events, Holidays or Holiday weekends in accordance with the plans and specifications, or as directed by the Engineer.

All lane closures and operations must be coordinated with existing construction contracts in the area.

No partial payments, including payment for stockpile materials, shall be made before work begins.
